### *The impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on community music*

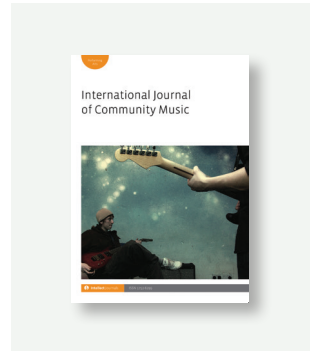
